### Find and Cite Your Source! (Correctly!)

For EVERY project in this class (and, in reality, every class) it is absolutely necessary to CITE YOUR SOURCES ACCURATELY. It is NOT OKAY to grab data, graphics, sounds, pictures and music off the internet for your personal use without at LEAST accurately citing where those sources came from. In some cases you may be violating copyright law!
