### QUICK START: Getting started in Photoshop:

1) **OPEN PHOTOSHOP FIRST:** Adobe Photoshop CS4

2) File → Open → mrswoodell.jpg (or any other face shot image ☺)

3) Show: your **TOOLS** **LAYERS** and **HISTORY**

(Window → tools Window → layers Window → history)

4) **CLEAR THE LOCKED BACKGROUND:**

Double click the background LAYER.

"Background" → Layer from Background

**Key:**

⌘ + / ⌘ - = Zoom in/out

⌘ T = Transform (pull corners)

⌘ D = Deselect

⌘ U = Hue Color changes

T = Text Tool (for typing words on image)

fx = Effects

Filter → liquify (for other cool effects)
