(Longterm ongoing project: Using Fireworks, Photoshop and Dreamweaver, create and maintain an interactive website.)

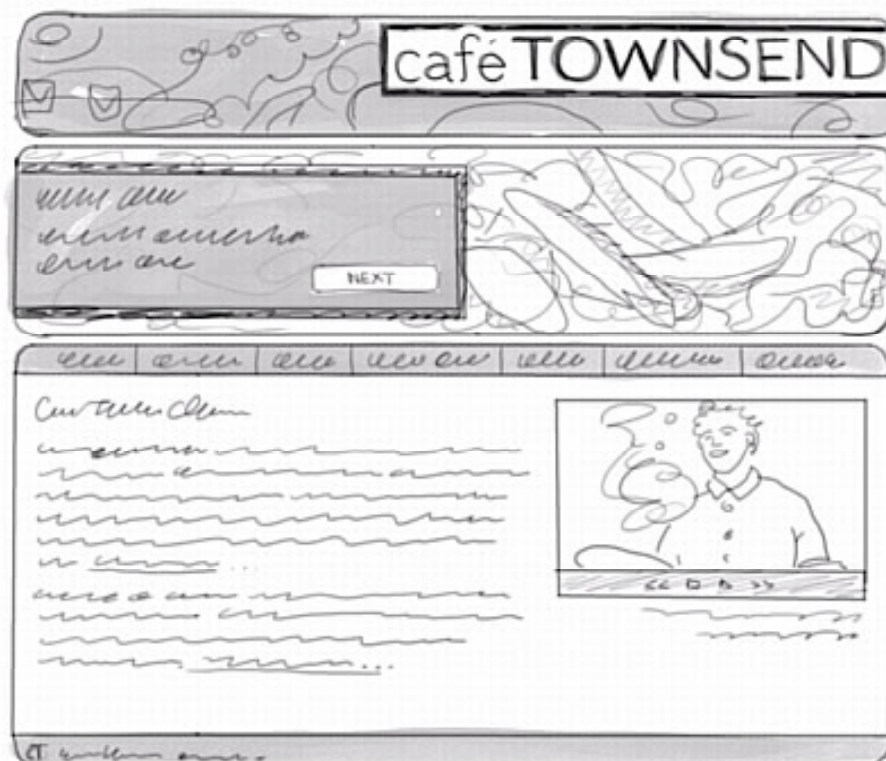

Find THREE other websites that have an INTERACTIVE WEB BANNER that guides their entire website:

I. Using the idea of "rectangles" and "tables" sketch out your idea for your webbanner and template: (on the back of this page)



II. Create a heading/logo:

Using Photoshop, create a .jpg image or logo for your personal website.



Include and group:

- Text
- Graphic(s)

III. Create the buttons:

Using Photoshop or Fireworks, create the buttons that you will need for your webpage. (save as .jpg)



IV. Create your Web Banner image

Create a web banner for your site. (750 pixels wide)

Include:

- Image
- Graphic Shape/color block
- Logo
- Subtext



IV. Create your Pull down menu bar:

- Use Fireworks:
 - Select a **hotspot** that becomes the trigger area for the pop-up menu.
 - Select Modify > Pop-up Menu > Add Pop-up Menu.
 - Click the Content tab and then click the Add Menu.
 - Double-click each cell and enter or select the appropriate Text, Link, and Target information. For the Link and Target fields, enter custom information or select from the displayed menus. Entering content on the last line in the window adds an empty line below it.

- Save as fireworks .html in SEPARATE folder w/in your web folder.
